









Urgency to Support Families to File



Enhanced 2021 tax benefits (more \$ available to more people) *expire April 2025*.



Financial hardship has been increasing for these low-income families (IRS data indicate average household AGI of \$19-20,000)



Goal of 2,000 new filers









What benefits are available?

- + Federal Earned Income Tax Credit up to \$6,700-\$7,400* per family, depending on the number of children and the tax year.
 - → State Earned Income Tax Credits between 30-40% of the Federal EITC
- + Federal Child Tax Credit Between \$2,000 and \$3,600 per child, with no work income required in 2021

Who qualifies for free tax prep services?

Filers who...

- Make up to \$64,000
- Have a disability, or
- Speak limited English
- An IRS-certified tax preparer is ready to work with filers to get their unclaimed cash benefits. They will work with filers every step of the way to get them the refund they are owed.











What information is needed to file taxes?

- Filers will need materials including:
 - Social Security card or Individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN) (for themselves and dependents, if any)
 - A government-issued photo ID
 - Any income documents received, such as W2s/1099 forms


